

SCORING PROCEDURES FOR ZONE SPORTING

LIVE SCORING FOR SPORTING EVENTS

The main Timekeeper will advise the Tablet scorer of the time for the rider that has just completed the sporting event, the Tablet scorer will enter the rider's time against the Rider's name and will compare the time recorded against the Stopwatch or the Electronic Timer and the main Timekeeper will check the data entry.

Tablet scoring – there are two columns for each Rider for recording their times. Column headed MIN – this is where the riders Minutes of their time are recorded. The Column headed SEC – this is where the riders Seconds and 10ths of Seconds are recorded, if the rider is eliminated then an E or X or DNF can be entered into either or both columns. If the rider is Eliminated or Disqualified, the Backup Timekeeper will record the Rider's Back No or Name, their time and the reason they were disqualified on paper that the Office will provide on a clipboard.

The Tablet scoresheet will automatically place the riders in their correct placings.

In the above example Rider 2 has won this event and Rider 3 has come second and Rider 2 has come third.

After the time for the last rider in the age group the Tablet scorer will be able to advise the riders placings and ribbons can be awarded as per those results. EVENTS WITH FINALS, the Tablet scorer will be able to advise the riders who are in the finals and what lane they will be running the event in. 5th & 6th Place getters can be award their ribbons.

FINALS

After a final has been run, the Official/Judge/Zone President (or whoever has been assigned this position) will advise the Tablet scorer the order the Riders crossed the finish line, the Tablet scorer will enter the placings as just 1, 2, 3 or 4 against the riders name in the Finals Section of the Tablet scoresheet.

POINTSCORING FOR SPORTING CLASSES

The fastest time down in each sporting event in each age group will be awarded 1st to 6th and will be awarded points as per below :

Equals are scored by adding the placing points together and dividing them the number of equal placings involved, for eg: =2nd/3rd in sporting event - 2nd = 5 Points & 3rd = 4 Points totalled = 9 points so each rider will be awarded 4.5 Points

SPORTING CHAMPIONS

Group Champions

In the event of a tie in points for individual champions a count back will take place to the highest number of first places then the highest number of second places and so on, if this does not decide the placing then the count back will then go back to the first sporting event.

SCORING PROCEDURES FOR ZONE CAMPDRAFTING

LIVE SCORING FOR CAMPDRAFTING

The Campdraft Judge will advise the Campdrafting/Board scorer of the Cut-Out, Horse Work & Course scores. The Tablet scorer will enter these points against the Rider's Back No/Name, under the appropriate columns, the points awarded in these three sections will be available LIVE but the placings for Campdraft won't be LIVE.

Placing riders

First Placings

In the event of equality for first placings, a count back will be conducted as under:

1. Cut out
2. Horse work
3. Course

If equality still exists at the end of this count back a further run-off will take place.

Minor Placings

Count back system will apply from this point to determine further placings, as under:

1. Cut out
2. Horse work
3. Course

Results as per above calculations each age group will be awarded 1st to 6th and will be awarded points as per below :

CAMPDRAFT CHAMPIONS

Group Champions

If there are two rounds of Campdrafting, the points awarded as per their placings in each round of the Campdraft Championship will be added together, in the event of a tie, a countback to the Highest Total Points, if the Total Points are equal then the Championship will go back to the Highest:

1. Total Cut out
2. Total Horse work
3. Total Course

If there is only one round of Campdrafting, then the Championship is calculated on the Highest score.

DRIFT TROPHY CALCULATION

The Total points for Sporting and Campdrafting for each rider are added together. The points for the top four riders in each Club are added together. The four riders in the Club with the highest points are awarded the Drift Trophy.
